Dear, Dear, Family of God:

As we write this letter we have just celebrated the birthday of Martin Luther King Jr. He was a man who was driven by a vision of a world in which all people were seen as equally the children of God. He had a vision in which justice would reign and all would equally be served by this justice. He held up the vision of Jesus that the weakest and those on the "outside" especially, needed to be cared for and supported. And he held up a vision of peace. His methods were non-violent and he called for an end to war and hatred in all its forms.

Yet, the hatred, the inequity, the injustice, and the oppression of the world continue. The brokenness of the world maybe different than in King's day either in method or target, and yet they continue. It sometimes seems easy to despair. But King believed that it was faith in God that kept us from giving up. King reminded us that the message of Jesus was not just a spiritual message, but was, dare we say it, a political message as well.



From the beginning Jesus held up a vision of a new world order filled with all King preached and stood for. And King believed that the Church was to be the carrier of this vision.

In every age the Church needs to be an agent for bringing in a new world. We know we never will, not by our own power. Only our Lord can truly bring in the Kingdom. But we can stand as heralds of that Kingdom in our lives. We can give our lives to the vision of our Lord who believed that the world should be guided by love, love that embraces all, and justice merged with mercy that sought the best for all people and treated all with equity.

We are proud that Trinity holds on to this vision in all they do. We are proud of our welcome statement. We are proud of our work in the community with those who it would be easy to forget. We are proud of our commitment to share the love and promise of God with the world. But there is much to do.

## FEBRUARY BOOK STUDY

This month's book study is **Leadership: In Turbulent Times** by Doris Kearns Goodwin. In **Leadership**, Goodwin draws upon the four presidents she has studied most closely—Abraham Lincoln, Theodore Roosevelt, Franklin D. Roosevelt, and Lyndon B. Johnson (in civil rights)—to show how they recognized leadership qualities within themselves and were recognized as leaders by others. By looking back to their first entries into public life, we encounter them at a time when their paths were filled with confusion, fear, and hope.

**Leadership** tells the story of how they all collided with dramatic reversals that disrupted their lives and threatened to shatter forever their ambitions. Nonetheless, they all emerged fitted to confront the contours and dilemmas of their times.

We will discuss this book on **Monday February 25<sup>th</sup> at 1:00.** If there are some people who would like to meet in the evening to discuss this book let me know and we will arrange an opportunity. We hope you can join us.

## KEEPING THE PROMISE/FIRST COMMUNION

### “Keeping the Promise” Rotation will be starting Feb. 10<sup>th</sup>

“Keeping the Promise” is a special rotation presented within Trinity’s children’s ministry every year. It is made up of five workshops especially designed to help each grade level develop a deeper understanding of one aspect of the promise their parents made for them at their baptisms. This rotation is designed directly from the baptismal vows:

*In Christian love you have presented this child for Holy Baptism. You should, therefore, faithfully **bring him/her to the services of God's house, and teach him/her the Lord's Prayer, the Creed, and the Ten Commandments.** As he/she grows in years, you should place in his/her hands **the Holy Scriptures** and provide for his/her instruction in the Christian faith, that, living in the covenant of their Baptism and in communion with the Church, he/she may lead a godly life until the day of Jesus Christ.*

For five weeks each 1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> Grader will be exposed to five different presentations of the baptismal focus for their grade level:

- 1<sup>st</sup> Grade – The Lord’s Prayer**
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade – The Ten Commandments**
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade – The Books of the Bible**
- 4<sup>th</sup> Grade – The Apostle’s Creed**
- 5<sup>th</sup> Grade – The Worship Service and Communion**



To be fully successful, this rotation will require that each child’s loved ones discuss their topics and work with them to learn the material. This rotation will also include presentations and celebrations. **For the 5<sup>th</sup> Graders, “Keeping the Promise” includes the First Communion workshop on Friday and Saturday, February 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>, and their First Communion on March 3<sup>rd</sup>.**

This rotation requires extra work on the part of the shepherds, rotation leaders and parents. But it is our attempt to faithfully “keep the promise” we all made to God and our children.



### **First Communion Workshop February 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup>, 2019**

All 5<sup>th</sup> grade (or above) youth **AND** their parents are invited to come to a special workshop that will prepare them to receive their **First Communion during a Worship Service on Sunday, March 3<sup>rd</sup>**. (As part of their “Keeping the Promise Rotation” **they will also be leading this worship service**).

The workshop involves **two sessions** with a group meal following the Saturday morning session. This year's dates are **Friday, February 8<sup>th</sup> from 6:30 pm to 8:30 pm and Saturday, February 9<sup>th</sup> from 9:30pm to Noon**. This workshop is for **BOTH the youth AND their parent(s)**. We realize that this is a significant block of time, but have found it to be a good time of spiritual growth and sharing for the youth, their parents and their whole families.

Parents, please take seriously how important your own faith journey is to the spiritual development of your children!

**We will try to arrange additional childcare for younger siblings at the church if this would help you – PLEASE LET US KNOW ASAP!**
