## Our Family in Christ,

This month we celebrate Valentine’s Day. Some have argued that it was a day created to capitalize on people buying stuff for the one’s they love. That is probably a fair critique. But there can be some incredible ways that love breaks through even in such a blatantly commercial day. True love can be revealed even in a world where we reserve our love for the loveable among us. There was a great story in one of the Chicken Soup books submitted by Dale Galloway.

*Little Chad was a shy, quiet young man. One day he came home and told his mother that he'd like to make a valentine for everyone in his class. Her heart sank. She thought, "I wish he wouldn't do that!" because she had watched the children when they walked home from school. Her Chad was always behind them. They laughed and hung on to each other and talked to each other. But Chad was never included. Nevertheless, she decided she would go along with her son. So she purchased the paper and glue and crayons. For three weeks, night after night, Chad painstakingly made 35 valentines.*

*Valentine's Day dawned, and Chad was beside himself with excitement. He carefully stacked them up, put them in a bag, and bolted out the door. His mother decided to bake him his favorite cookies and serve them nice and warm with a cool glass of milk when he came home from school. She just knew he would be disappointed and maybe that would ease the pain a little. It hurt her to think that he wouldn't get many valentines-maybe none at all.*

*That afternoon she had the cookies and milk on the table. When she heard the children outside, she looked out the window. Sure enough, there they came, laughing and having the best time. And, as always, there was Chad in the rear. He walked a little faster than usual. She fully expected him to burst into tears as soon as he got inside. His arms were empty, she noticed, and when the door opened she choked back the tears. "Mommy has some cookies and milk for you," she said. But he hardly heard her words. He just marched right on by, his face aglow, and all he could say was: "Not a one. Not a one." Her heart sank. And then he added, "I didn't forget a one, not a single one!"*

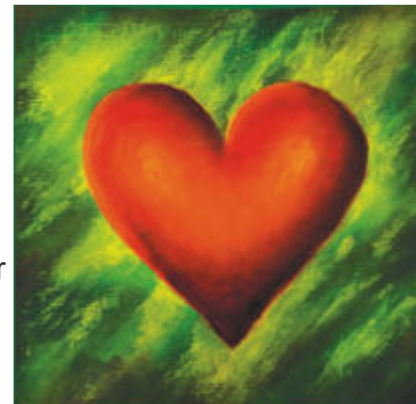
This is the love of God which has not missed a single one of us. During Epiphany we look for the revelations of God’s overwhelming love and we find it revealed in

amazing places. And we pray during this season that like Chad we might learn to love each other as Christ has loved us.

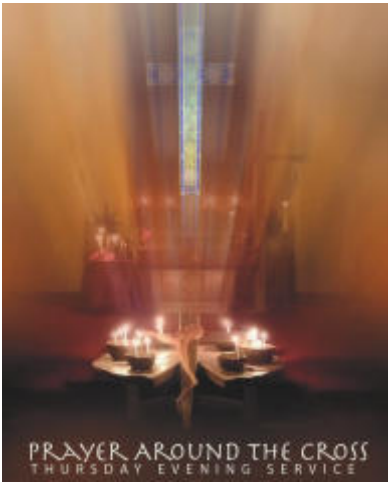

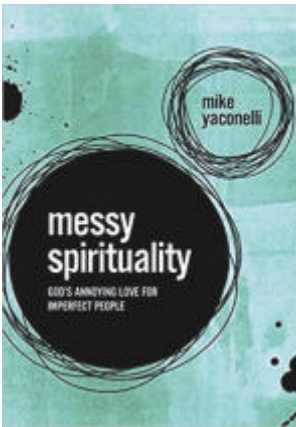

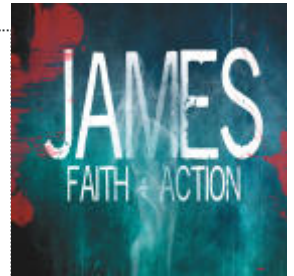
### A Good Read

# HELP WANTED

Seeking individuals to take over coordination of existing outreach programs with established organizational structure & resources.

## THE GATHERING

Is feeding the hungry important to you?  
Work with The Gathering to set up  
1-2 service days per year.

**Skills:** E-mail and written notices.

**Tasks:** Contact The Gathering to choose date. Provide information and signup via paper & Signup Genius to congregation. Follow up with volunteers prior to service day. Share event summary with congregation.

**Time Required:** ~2 hours, per service event. (Not including day of event.)

## HELP LOCAL CHILDREN IN NEED "BRIEF APPEAL"

**Skills:** E-mail communication.

**Tasks:** Contact WBHS nurse. Provide information to congregation and set up collection hamper. Sort donations of collected underwear for school delivery by size/gender and school need (per HS nurse). Coordinate delivery to schools. Followup summary to congregation.

**Time Required:** 4-8 hours (flexible)

**Note:** Sorting & delivery of 2020 Brief Appeal donations will occur in early February.

## FAMILY PROMISE

**Wanted:** People with a passion to help our community by supporting homeless families working to achieve sustainable independence. This position could be filled by 1 or 2 people/families working together.

**Skills:** Organization. E-mail. Computer skills a plus.

**Tasks:** Organize 4 host weeks per year. Coordinate volunteers who provide food/meals, dinner service, fellowship, overnight stays. Set up guest rooms. Monitor and replenish supplies.

**Time Required:** Variable prior to and during host week. Bimonthly, ~ 1 hr, evening meeting with Family Promise case manager and other church coordinators.

**Note:** Trinity's next host week is Feb 16-23. This would be a great opportunity to shadow current coordinators!

**Tasks:** Coordinate a date for a Trinity Habitat Build. Promote the build day via newsletter and bulletins, etc. Provide Signup Genius and paper signups. **Time Required:** 1-2 hours (plus build day)
