Dear Family of God,

We follow Jesus to the cross during the season of Lent. Such a trip is never easy for we come face to face with the worst of ourselves. Jesus is placed on the cross by selfishness, fear, anger, division, hatred, and all the darkest parts of who we are individually and as people in general. We have confronted our limitations and mortality at Ash Wednesday and each day of Lent is another confrontation with who we are. But Jesus goes to the cross to reveal that is not all we are.

God created us as good and within us is also the power of love, curiosity, beauty, care, compassion, hope, and all that makes life worth living. Dust, sin, death may threaten to define all we are, but we received those ashes in the sign of a cross to remind us that is not all we are. God continues to breathe life into us and Jesus gives us a vision of what God intended at the beginning.

Jesus shows us in the cross the power of a love that gives itself in hopes of bringing life to the world. We reflect on that as we examine the seven last words of our Lord from the cross during this Lenten season. In those words Jesus calls us to forgiveness, inclusion, awareness of the suffering of others, our nature as family of God, our struggle to find hope in the deepest darkness, our trust in God and one another, and our belief in the kingdom that God is calling into being. We renew our belief that though we struggle against sin, death and the devil and it threatens to overwhelm us; the victory has already been won in our Lord Jesus Christ.

In Jesus Christ we are free. We are free to choose to pick up our cross and follow. We are free to start over again and walk the path of loving service. We are free to embrace the identity that God gave each of us at baptism. If we were left to our own devices this would never be—but in Christ a miracle occurs. Martin Luther expressed this in a Lenten Prayer:

Lord Jesus,
You are my righteousness,
I am your sin.
You took on you what was mine;
yet set on me what was yours.
You became what you were not,
that I might become what I was not.
Amen



The February meeting of the Trinity quilt ladies was very productive. It was discovered that Immanuel Church Circle of Friends shop would be able to share some blankets with people in need in West Bend. Additionally, we found out Immanuel is also connected with Mr. Bob's Under the Bridge helping homeless in our community. With the help of Tom Bulin and his truck, 70 blankets were delivered!

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come. —2 Corinthians 5:17

Our Savior's Church in West Bend asked if we could help them serve their sister church in a desperately low income area in Milwaukee. They said they could use 10-15 blankets. 35 blankets were delivered!

While we continue to make the 60x80-inch blankets for **Lutheran World Relief**, there has been a suggestion that we also create some **baby size blankets** using soft flannel. *That new ministry is in the works!*

With a renewed purpose and intentions of expanding our ministry, the quilters decided it was time to change our name as well. We will now be known as the *Trinity Comforters*. This name not only speaks to what we like to give the most—*comfort!*, it provides a broader stroke as we would like to move this outreach ministry beyond just blankets. We plan to help Trinity connect with members and friends through other means, such as sending cards, notes or making phone calls.


