Yet as their families grieved, we saw people surround them with love and support. ***Jesus was there in the midst of death through many of you.*** We were blessed to see this, and it brought us joy and comfort.

We were blessed to see the wedding of our son and new daughter, Curt and Emily. The wedding and everything leading up to it was a true expression of both their individuality and their love for one another. It was also a special time for us to spend with Nick who was home for the wedding. ***Only God could create such a special time in our lives. The love shared over those weeks truly reminded us of what love is meant to be and reminded us of the love God has for us.*** We were truly blessed.

Early in August we supported and represented Trinity by participating in the second annual Pride celebration in Allenton. What a great event for all who attended. There was such support, encouragement, respect and great care for everyone in that place. The organizers did a great job of creating an event that was very family friendly. It was so fun watching the children enjoy the day. It was a sign of how we could and *should* live together. ***And, it was a glimpse of the beloved community that Christ came to show us.***

***It is the experience of Christ among us (in the every day) that continues to strengthen us and call us to live as God's people.*** These moments remind us that the world is filled with possibility and that God is not done with us yet.

*Did you see Christ among us this summer?*  
**Don't be afraid to share it with one another.**

Soon it will be Rally Day and the return to the normal schedules of life in the church—***continue to look for Christ in the moments.*** In our lives may these experiences remind us that we are always founded on Christ, the rock of our salvation, whose strength always lifts us up.

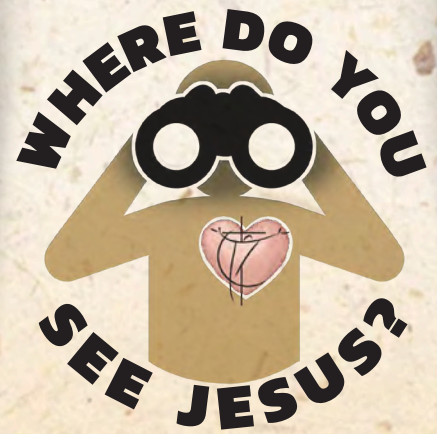

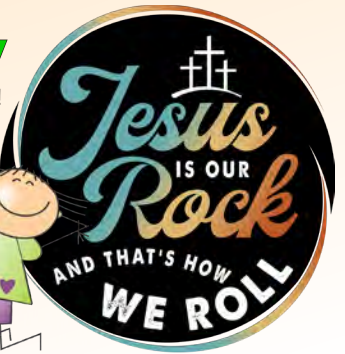

The *Trinity* comforters meet at church on Thursdays at 1 PM and are one of the most active ministry groups here at Trinity.

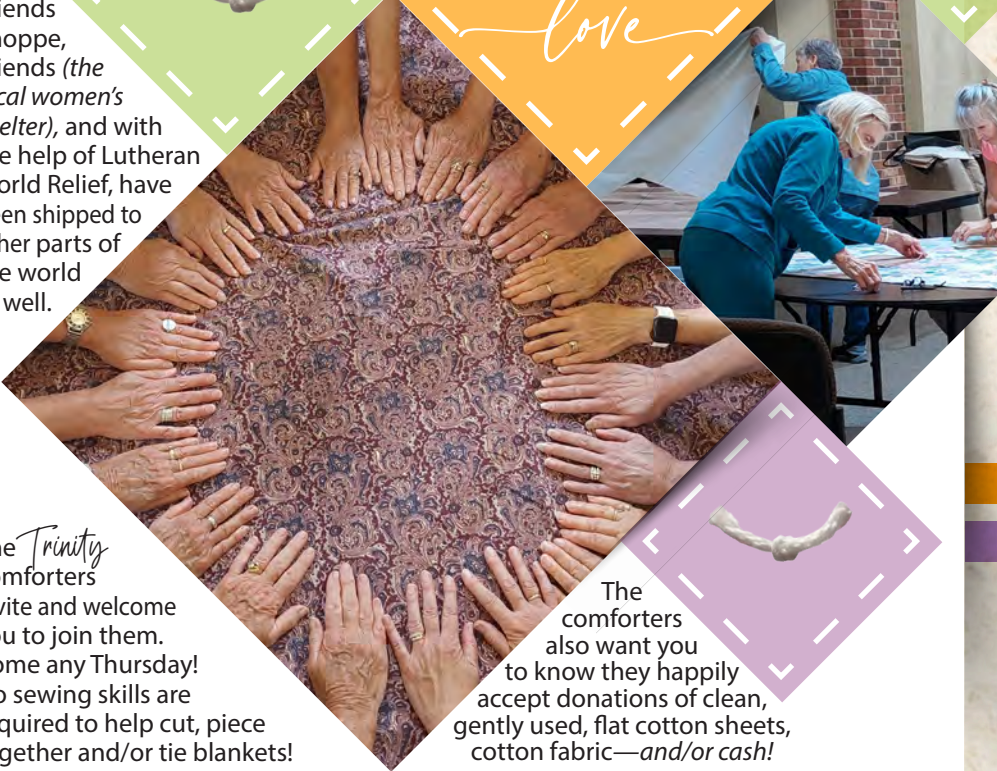
Currently, there are eleven women who gather to make blankets each week. They truly enjoy the work they do together and value the connections and friendships they have developed in the process.

We will return to meeting for Bible Study on Tuesday afternoons at 1 PM, beginning September 12th—with a study of the book of Ecclesiastes.

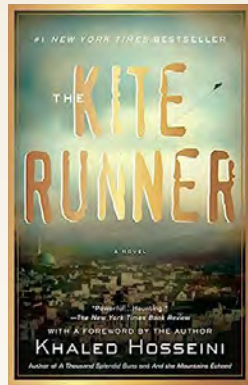

## BOOK STUDY | THE KITE RUNNER THURSDAY | SEPTEMBER 28 | 7 PM



Our book for the month of September will be **The Kite Runner** by **Khaled Hosseini**. This is a powerful story about abuse, betrayal, forgiveness and redemption.

**HERE IS A SYNOPSIS FROM AMAZON:** The unforgettable, heartbreaking story of the unlikely friendship between a wealthy boy and the son of his father's servant, caught in the tragic sweep of history, *The Kite Runner* transports readers to Afghanistan at a tense and crucial moment of change and destruction. A powerful story of friendship, it is also about the power of reading, the price of betrayal, and the possibility of redemption; and an exploration of the power of fathers over sons—their love, their sacrifices, their lies.

Since its publication in 2003, *The Kite Runner* has become a beloved, one-of-a-kind classic of contemporary literature—touching millions of readers, and launching the career of one of America's most treasured writers.

This book has been in the West Bend News. The school district was challenged by people to drop the book from their reading list and library. But the school chose to keep it on an optional reading list.
