Members and Friends of Trinity,

It is February, and in this month we will begin the season of Lent. Lent is connected to penitence, confession, sacrifice, preparation, renewal—and *all these are true*. But, let us offer you a little different picture to prepare you for the Lenten journey.

This year Ash Wednesday and Valentine's Day are the same day. At first this might seem like a strange pairing. But let's consider the mating of these two days.

Ash Wednesday is the recognition of our mortality, our sinfulness, our frailty. The words which focus our attention on Ash Wednesday are, "*You are dust, and to dust you shall return.*" This can be a painful and difficult reality for us to face.

Yet there is one power greater . . . **LOVE.**

We celebrate love on Valentine's Day - *the love of those close to us*. We also celebrate love on Ash Wednesday. We apply the ashes of mortality in the shape of a cross - **the sign of God's gift of a love so deep that it would die for us so that we might have life.**

Beginning on Ash Wednesday and continuing through the Lenten season we recognize the brokenness, the frailty, the limited nature of life and the world. But we also recognize that in the love that God shares with us, and the love we share with each other, we are so much more than the limits of our lives. **We are God's children and not even the dust of death can change that reality.**

We can now face life with joy and hope, *not denying the pain and struggle, but engaging the brokenness of the world with the love of God.* We pray more fervently for the world and for those we love. We spend more time in the presence of the God who comes to the cross for us. We fast, not in righteousness, but in solidarity with those who are hungry, and as a reminder that God is the greatest sustainer of us all. We set aside resources from our own blessings—using them to reach out in love to those in need in places or situations where that need touches our hearts the most.

In the face of the proclamation, "*You are dust and to dust you shall return,*" we hear with joy the words of Christ, "*For God so loved the world that he gave his only son, so that all who believe in him should not perish but have eternal life.*"

And so we enter the season and the journey of Lent. *May it open the doors of our hearts a little wider and the understanding our Lord a little deeper so that when Good Friday and Easter come, it is not just another day at church but an opportunity to receive the overflowing graces God has to offer.*

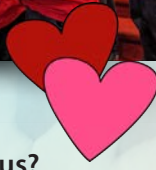

Looking ahead to Lent
—because, you can't know the joy of Easter without first going to the cross.

Beginning on Ash Wednesday, Lent is a time when we prepare ourselves for Easter and are invited to deeper faith, stronger community, and a closer connection to God. This preparation happens through an emphasis on a few basic faith practices: worship, prayer, generosity, self-denial, and service to others.

Journey to the Cross is our Lenten theme this year. Our worship will follow Jesus and his disciples in the gospel of Mark from Caesarea Phillipi to Jerusalem—as they move ever closer to the cross. As Jesus travels to the cross, it is revealed what it means to live life in the shadow of the cross.

The imposition of ashes on Ash Wednesday remind us of our mortality. Ash Wednesday isn't a cheerful celebration. But it can be the beginning of a changed life.

"Hosanna" to "Crucify Him"—Holy Week begins on Palm/Pasassion weekend when Trinity's Confirmation Youth conduct worship through dialog and portrayal.

Maundy Thursday is a solemn day that commemorates Jesus' Last Supper with his disciples and reminds us of the importance of humility, selflessness, and service to others. Jesus washed the feet of his disciples as an example that no one is above being a servant to one another and stated: "A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another" —JOHN 13:34

Because you can't know the joy of Easter morning without first going to the cross. Reflecting on how much Christ sacrificed and suffered to pay for our sins deepens the joy and gratitude we feel for the gift of new life that we celebrate on Easter Sunday.

Keeping the Promise Rotation BEGINS!

KEEPING THE PROMISE is a special rotation presented within Trinity's Children's Ministry program every year. It is made up of six workshops designed to help each grade level develop a deeper understanding of one aspect of the promise their parents made for them at their baptisms.

This rotation is designed directly from the baptismal vows:

In Christian love you have presented this child for Holy Baptism. You should, therefore, faithfully bring him/her to the services of God's house, and teach him/her the Lord's Prayer, the Creed, and the Ten Commandments. As he/she grows in years, you should place in his/her hands the Holy Scriptures and provide for his/her instruction in the Christian faith, that, living in the covenant of their Baptism and in communion with the Church, he/she may lead a godly life until the day of Jesus Christ.

For four weeks each 3 year old– 6th Grader will be exposed to different presentations of the baptismal focus for their grade level:

- Little Lambs | Baptism/Prayer/The Church
- 1st - 2nd Grade | The Lord's Prayer/The Ten Commandments
- 3rd Grade | The Books of the Bible
- 4th Grade | The Apostle's Creed
- 5th Grade | Worship and Communion
