

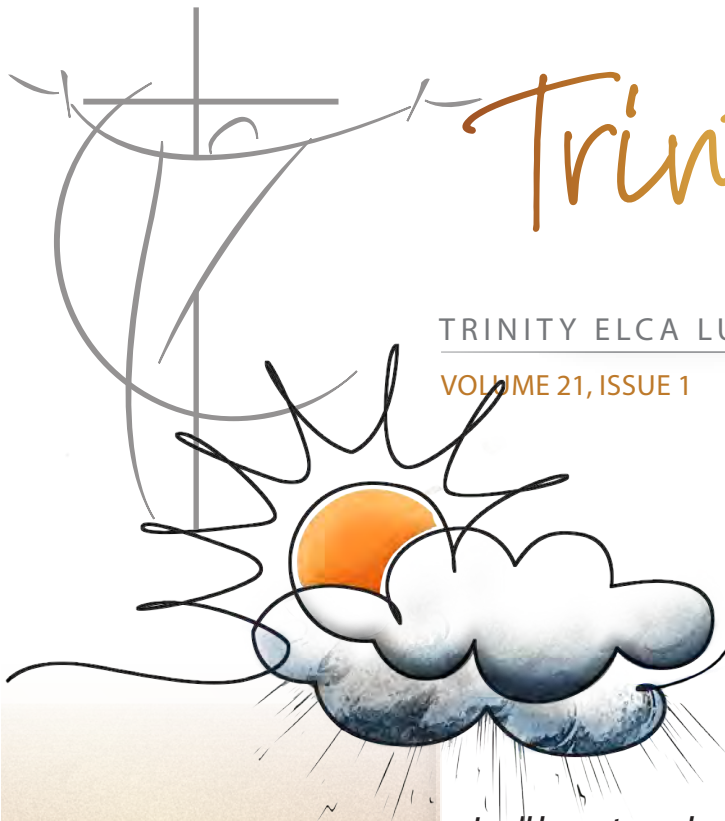

NEW** can go either way. A new boss, a new job, a new worship service, a new political administration, new rules, new expectations, new relationships, a new year. **The truth is our reaction to either way of what is NEW is often based on our own inner state.

*In the left column are the words Paul wrote when he was in jail—PHILIPPIANS 4. He talked about and used his time in jail as a time to share the witness of God's love to those who were his jailers. Paul's reaction to the undesirable circumstances he was in, was to focus and rejoice in the knowledge and trust that Jesus' love surrounded him in every moment—**through all the good and all the bad.***

*As we enter this **NEW** year, may we do it with the knowledge, trust and mindset that, **no matter what comes**, it will be intertwined amidst the always present love of God. Keeping God in the center of our hearts and minds may change how we see and react to the **NEW** things—**good or bad**—that are yet to come.*

*Whatever challenges the **NEW** year may hold, know that it will also be blessed by God's love in Jesus Christ. **Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, Rejoice. May your hearts and minds be filled with the peace of God in every circumstance of the NEW year.***

The winter months have arrived and **Project RETURN** is looking for warm clothing. All ADULT SIZES (*from Small to 5x*) of the following are needed:

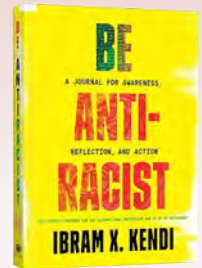

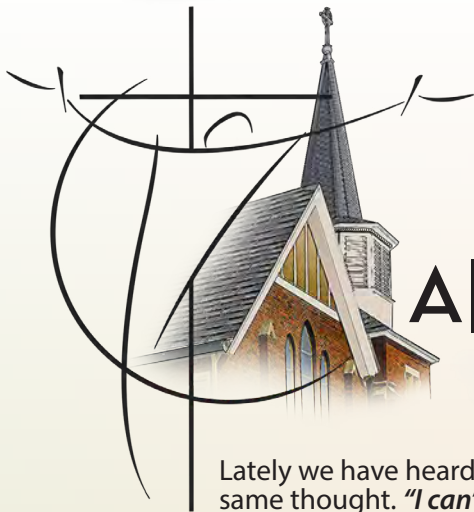

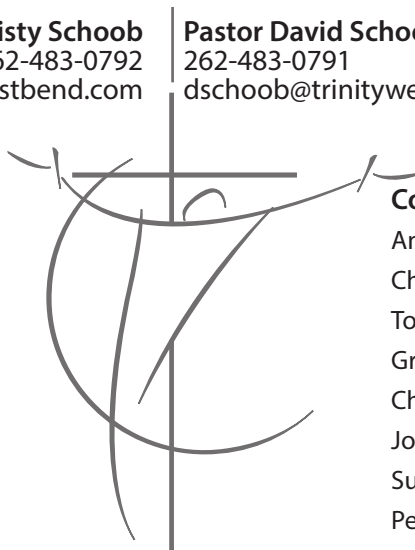
