Lent has arrived again.

In this season we take time to renew our commitment to the path that Jesus offers us. The path is best described by Jesus in his words, **“Anyone who would be my disciple must take up their cross and follow me.”**

During the 40 days of the Lenten season we renew our commitment to the path of sacrificial love. We renew our relationship with Christ and with others as we confess our sins and repent. We turn around and set a new course. We sacrifice our pride, and we admit we need a new start. **We cannot be the disciples Jesus calls us to be unless we allow the grace of God to make us new.**

We sacrifice our time and our resources to serve God in love through worship and to the world through acts of kindness, service and charity. **Observing the season of Lent allows us to renew our connection with the needs of the world as we simplify our lives and re-prioritize our indulgences—not just for the sake of discipline, but so there is more for those who are in need.** In our fasting we accompany, *as best we can*, those who go hungry every night. We pray for them as well as offer gifts to fill their hunger.

This is not to make us more worthy or righteous, it is to reconnect us to the path that Jesus trod. In the end, it is the path he promises that provide us blessings we cannot imagine—*both here and in the life to come.*

The early Christians were called followers of **“the way.”** Luther often talked of **“the way of the cross,”** as the true calling of a Christian.

Let us all follow the way of the cross as we make our Lenten journey together practicing the sacrificial love that has saved us all.

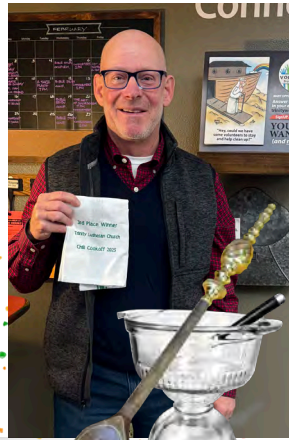
WAYS TO FAST THIS LENT

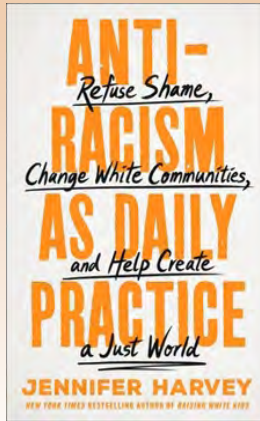

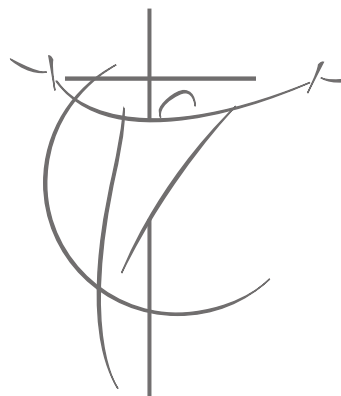
