3º So Jacob called the place Peniel, saying, "It is because I saw God face to face, and yet my life was spared."


31 The sun rose above him as he passed Peniel, [c] and he was limping because of his hip.

THE GOSPEL Luke 18:1-8

Then Jesus^[a] told them a parable about their need to pray always and not to lose heart. ² He said, "In a certain city there was a judge who neither feared God nor had respect for people. ³ In that city there was a widow who kept coming to him and saying, 'Grant me justice against my accuser.' ⁴ For a while he refused, but later he said to himself, 'Though I have no fear of God and no respect for anyone, ⁵ yet because this widow keeps bothering me, I will grant her justice, so that she may not wear me out by continually coming.' THE COMMUNION SENTENCES

- P: We are a resurrection people
- C: We come to share in the table Jesus has prepared for us. We come to lean on the power that brings new beginnings out of painful endings.
- P: We are Easter people
- C: Just as we share his death, we share his life. We are freed to live without fear. We, too, will be raised from death to life.
- P: We are Good News people!
- C: We are caught up in the activity of our lives and need to pause and be refreshed. In these elements of love, we find strength to live lives that reflect God's light. We are not left alone with the darkness that terrifies us, or the sin that separates us. The body and blood of Jesus are a very real presence among us. We come to the table to find forgiveness, healing, acceptance and strength.
- P: Our Lord Jesus, on the night in which he was betrayed took bread, and gave thanks. He broke it and gave it to his disciples saying, "Take and eat, this is my body given for you. Do this to remember me." Again after supper he took the cup, he gave thanks and gave it for all to drink saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, shed for you and for all people for the forgiveness of sin. Do this to remember me!" Following our Lord's command and responding to our need for forgiveness, we come!

- P: Send now your Holy Spirit, upon this bread and wine and all who gather at this table. By your Spirit make our hearts burn and open our eyes that we may become what we receive, the body of Christ given for the life of the world.

All who celebrate Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior are invited to commune today.


When you receive the bread, you may either dip the wafer in the first chalice of wine or the second chalice of grape juice Please indicate to the pastor if you need a gluten free wafer.
