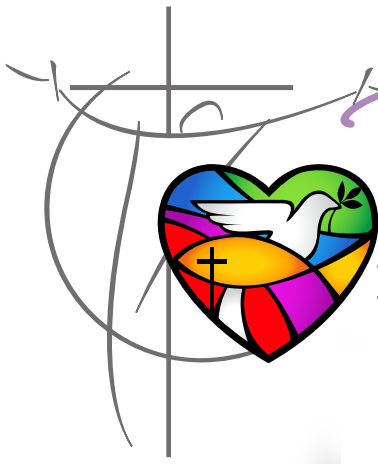

Trinity friends and members,

TRINITY TOGETHER BY *Grace and Gratitude* is our **Stewardship theme and our call to spiritual discipline**. It recognizes the undeserved gift of grace each of us receives from God and the anchor of gratitude for that gift that keeps us grounded.

The response to *Grace and Gratitude* is GIVING—it is the act (the discipline) that connects us. It's not about the size of the gift, but the sincerity of the heart behind it. The weekend of November 8-9 has been set aside to celebrate the gift of God's *Grace with Gratitude* as we Consecrate the 2026 Estimate of Giving cards brought forward at that time. Please join us in worship with joy and thanksgiving.

FUNDRAISER & MISSION HIGHLIGHTS

It is with a grateful heart, the Trinity Comforters group recognizes the congregational members, friends, and family for their support of our annual Books, Puzzles, Games & Jewelry Sale fundraiser. It was a successful event not only for raising funds (*over \$2,000*), but also serving as an outreach opportunity to the community and beyond.

Over 300 fiction paperback books were purchased by donation, to be used at the **Bethani Orphanage in India**, along with others going to local agencies like **Threshold**. On Saturday, we celebrated learning that the \$5+ bag of children's books was going to **Next Door Milwaukee Books for Kids**.

During the sale, our doors were open to welcome visitors who prayed in the church and visited 'Rory's Room'—while others expressed interest in joining our Thursday Comforters group.

The same weekend as the fundraising event, Diane Ferstadt and Pat Hanvey delivered **17 boxes containing a total of 136 blankets to the LWR (Lutheran World Relief)** drop off in Sheboygan. Trinity Comforters' ministry is fully supported by donations from individuals throughout the year and their annual fundraiser—they are not part of Trinity's budget. **We are truly blessed!**

PLANT A SEED CREATE A LEGACY

TRINITY'S MINISTRY EXPANDED AGAIN IN OCTOBER —with another chance in November

For several years Trinity has had a relationship with Family Promise of Washington County and its work with homeless men and families. Before COVID we housed and fed families for a week at a time—now we provide evening meals during a designated weeks.

In October a Trinity member's request was granted to fund some of the needs of Family Promise involving correction of a few of their building deficiencies.

Additionally October saw the final payment of \$3,400 being made, which completed the 3 year \$10,000 commitment (*matching gifts from individual Trinity members*) to the **Greater Milwaukee Synod's Equipping the Saints** fund raising effort.

WHAT WILL NOVEMBER BRING?

Endowment Funds are available to help us fulfill our congregation's mission to share the love and promise of God and expand our ministries through fund requests involving leadership development, community outreach, or greater church activities. **Fund requests need to be submitted by November 18**, the date of the Endowment Board's quarterly meeting. Forms for requests are available in the Heritage Room by the center column.

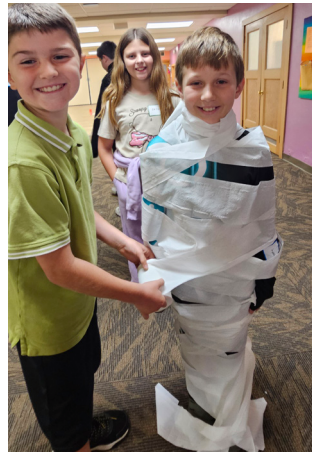

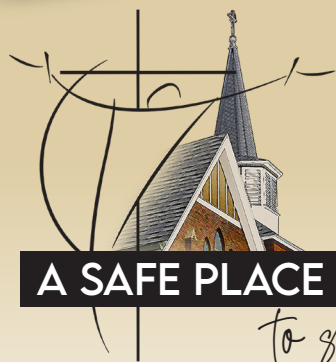
Incredible edibles returns For 2025!

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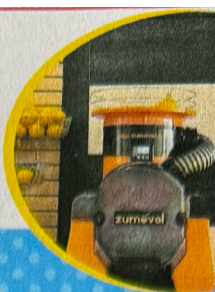
