Hello Members of Trinity Lutheran Church,

*I am looking forward to serving as your Interim Pastor, beginning in just a few weeks!* I have been serving as an Interim Pastor for five years now, at three different congregations. My first interim assignment was at Lakeview Lutheran Church in Madison where I served for 16 months. I was then at Bethlehem Lutheran Church in Brodhead for 10 months and then moved over to the Greater Milwaukee Synod where I have been serving North Cape Lutheran Church in Franksville for 2 1/2 years.

I am a lifelong Lutheran, having grown up in the Missouri Synod and the ALC prior to the formation of the ELCA.

I attended seminary at Trinity Lutheran Seminary in Columbus, OH and graduated with an M.Div. and an STM in 1997. Much to my surprise, I was then assigned to the South-Central Synod of Wisconsin and was called to serve a small 2-point parish in Bagley and Cassville. In 1998, I married Lisa Nelson, who is also an ELCA pastor, and we ended up moving to Sun Prairie, where we have been ever since. In 1999, I was called to St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Waterloo where I served until the beginning 2021.

Lisa and I have three sons. Matt, Nathan and Seth. Matt and Nathan are 24. Matt has worked with the Sun Prairie Fire Department since he graduated from high school and is living in Beaver Dam. Nathan served on active duty in the infantry in the USMC for 4 years and was stationed at Camp Pendleton in Oceanside, CA. He is now a part-time firefighter in Sun Prairie. Seth is 20 and a Junior at UW Whitewater studying Biology. We also have a West Highland White Terrier named Gandalf, a kitten named Frodo, and a Leopard Gecko named Spike.

I grew up in West Virginia, having moved from Ohio when I was five years old, and my parents and brother and sister still live in Charleston. Lisa grew up in Fresno, CA where her Dad lives, and also has family in Washington State, so many of our vacations involve us traveling either east or west.

*I am looking forward to meeting you and hearing your stories, especially about Trinity, your relationship with the congregation and the mission you have shared here over the years.* When I served at St. Paul's I not only served there for 20 years, but I followed a pastor who had served for 20 years (with an Interim Pastor between us). I understand the blessings of a long-term, stable pastorate, the routines that a congregation can get into, and the challenges of saying good-bye to pastors who have been such an integral part of your congregation and of your lives. No doubt, there have already been, and will continue to be, many changes at Trinity. Together, we will work our way through them and take the first steps into the next chapter of Trinity Lutheran Church.



## TRINITY RECEIVES THANK YOU FROM FAMILY PROMISE

For several years Trinity has had a relationship with Family Promise of Washington County and its work with homeless men and families. Before COVID we housed and fed families for a week at a time—now we provide evening meals during a designated weeks every few months. In October a Trinity member's request resulted in a grant of \$5,000 to help fund some of the needs of Family Promise involving correction of a few of their building deficiencies. Trinity received a letter of gratitude from Family Promise that also includes information about how the funds are helping them. 


## F.I.S.H. CHRISTMAS ESCAPE ROOM








## NEW, EARLIER TIME WEDNESDAYS | 5:30 PM

The following is from a nationwide survey conducted by JC Penney: "Based on 1-on-1 interviews, there is an increased need for basic necessities - like underwear - especially during the winter months. Yet, these items are often the least requested and least likely to be donated, as few people think to donate these to charity and those in need are often too embarrassed to proactively seek out underwear."

The survey also reported that 55% of children who did not have underwear and socks to wear wanted to skip school or refused to go to school because he or she was embarrassed at not having any. In addition, children may not have "extra" underwear that they can leave at school for "emergency" use.

We have been in touch with the West Bend School District nurses and all schools report a need for new underwear, female and male. For girls, the most needed are girls sizes 4-8, but there is also some need for size 10, 12, 14 as well as women's medium. The boys could use sizes 4-12, but they are more in need of the smaller sizes.
